

The Competition Commission (the Commission) is an independent statutory body established under the Competition Ordinance (Cap. 619) (the Ordinance) which was enacted in June 2012. The objectives of the Ordinance include the prohibition of conduct that prevents, restricts or distorts competition in Hong Kong.

Competition Affairs Officer (Investigations I) (Ref: CC/CAOIINVI20220608)

The job holder is responsible for conducting investigations into potential anti-competitive conduct in Hong Kong.

Responsibilities

- To carry out investigative steps, to review and analyse evidence in investigations into potential contraventions of the Competition Ordinance;
- To provide assistance to the Commission's legal counsel in enforcement litigation proceedings before the Competition Tribunal;
- To represent the Commission in public activities such as advocacy and educational initiatives if requested, and provide general support to the various other functions of the Commission; and
- To perform any other duties as assigned by supervisors.

Requirements

- A university degree, preferably in law or economics, or equivalent;
- 4 years' working experience in relevant fields (including legal, regulatory, law enforcement, compliance, economic research and advisory); experience in a regulatory or law enforcement authority or a role with regular dealings with regulatory authorities would be desirable;
- Good command of written and spoken English and Chinese, with strong presentation and writing skills;
- Strong research, analytical ability and solid data and project management skills;
- Proficiency in using MS Office software including Excel, Word and Power Point;
- Attentive to details and good organizing abilities; and
- Ability to work well in teams.

Candidates with less experience may be considered for a more junior position and a salary commensurate with their qualifications and experience.

Where a large number of candidates meet the specified entry requirements, the recruiting section may devise shortlisting criteria to select the better qualified candidates for further processing. In these circumstances, only shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend the written test and/or interview. Candidates who are selected for interview will normally receive an invitation in about six to eight weeks from the closing date.

All applications will be handled in strict confidence. Personal data collected from applicants will only be used for recruitment related purposes and will not be transferred to any third party. Personal data of unsuccessful applicants will be destroyed within 12 months of the recruitment process being completed by the appointment of a candidate for the relevant position.
