

The Competition Commission (the Commission) is an independent statutory body established under the Competition Ordinance (Cap. 619) (the Ordinance) which was enacted in June 2012. The objective of the Ordinance is to prohibit conduct that prevents, restricts or distorts competition, and to prohibit mergers that substantially lessen competition in Hong Kong. The scope of the application of the merger rule is limited to carrier licences issued under the Telecommunications Ordinance (Cap. 106).

Temporary Competition Affairs Officer, Investigations I (Operations) (Ref: CC/TCAO(II)INVI20200821)

The job holder is responsible for conducting investigations into potential anti-competitive conducts in Hong Kong.

Responsibilities

- To handle investigative steps and conduct factual and legal analysis of alleged contraventions of the Competition Ordinance;
- To take part in investigative actions of alleged contraventions;
- To assist internal and/or external legal counsels for investigations at the Litigation stage before the Competition Tribunal;
- To assess applications for Decisions or Block Exemption Orders; and
- To perform any other duties as assigned by supervisors.

Requirements

- A university degree, preferably in law or economics, or equivalent; and having 2 years' working experience in relevant fields.
- Good command of written and spoken English and Chinese, with strong presentation and writing skills:
- Strong research, analytical ability and solid project management skills;
- Proficiency in using MS Office software including Excel, Word and Power Point; and
- Attentive to details and good organizing abilities.

Terms of Appointment: Appointment will be offered on 1 year fixed-term contract, renewable

depending on performance and operational needs.

Basic Salary: Starting from HK\$14,965 per month and depending on experience.

Where a large number of candidates meet the specified entry requirements, the recruiting section may devise shortlisting criteria to select the better qualified candidates for further processing. In these circumstances, only shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend the written test and/or interview. Candidates who are selected for interview will normally receive an invitation in about six to eight weeks from the closing date.

Personal data of unsuccessful applicants will be destroyed within 12 months of the recruitment process being completed by the appointment of a candidate for the relevant position.
