**Competition Commission and CUHK LAW conduct
Autumn Academy on Competition Law and Policy**
A practical course for lawyers, compliance practitioners and businesses

The Competition Commission (Commission) and the Faculty of Law of the Chinese University of Hong Kong are conducting an online Autumn Academy on Competition Law and Policy (Academy) on 13, 17 and 18 November 2021. Registration for the Academy is now open.

This three half-day series is specially designed for lawyers, compliance practitioners and businesses with the aim of deepening their understanding of competition law and strengthening their capability to advise companies or clients on related matters. It will not only cover the key provisions of the Competition Ordinance, its practical applications and case studies, but also guidance on how to help their companies or clients ensure compliance and respond appropriately to an investigation.

Delivered by distinguished legal scholars, senior staff from the Commission and veteran competition lawyers in private practice, this academy offers a unique opportunity to hear from and pose questions to those who are experienced in leading and advising on the Commission's investigations. A renowned competition law professor from the Mainland will also give an overview of the competition law regime and the recent topical issues, such as enforcement actions relating to the digital economy in the Mainland.

The Academy is accredited with CPD points by the *Hong Kong Institution of Certified Auditors*, the *Hong Kong Institute of Directors* and the *Law Society of Hong Kong*.
